for 2017 LUCIA PINOT NOIRS



97 Lucia 2017 Garys' Vineyard Pinot Noir (Santa Lucia Highlands) PTS

Rich, clean and powerfully mineral-driven on the nose, this single-vineyard expression shows black cherry, tangy raspberry, crushed slated and damp gravel on the nose. There is tremendous depth of favor to the intensely elegant palate, where strong but perfectly ripe dark fruits are balanced by tightly woven tannins, fresh acidity and more rock and soil favors. —M.K.

96 Lucia 2017 Soberanes Vineyard Pinot Noir (Santa Lucia Highlands) PTS

Rich, deep, intense aromas of black cherry, loamy soil, bay leaf and the slightest hint of smoke show on the nose of this excellent bottling from the Pisoni family. There are plenty of earthy qualities to the tense palate, from sagebrush to slate-driven minerality, but also inviting tones of Bing cherry and ripe cranberry. —M.K.

94 Lucia 2017 Pinot Noir (Santa Lucia Highlands) PTS

This appellation blend is a compelling show of the region, starting with fresh and lively aromas of black cherry, raspberry, loamy soil and crushed slate. The earthy quality is prominent on the palate, but backed up by deep accents of boysenberry and cardamom. *Editors' Choice.* —M.K.
